

Maritime Resource Management (MRM) Training

In collaboration with the Swedish Club, GBLT Singapore will be conducting Maritime Resource Management training from 2010. Two training courses will be conducted in Jakarta and another two will be conducted in China for officers working in the fleet.

Maritime Resource Management (MRM) is a training programme that builds upon well-established facts as well as the latest research within the human factor areas. The training is designed to minimize the risk of incidents by encouraging safe and responsible behavior. It aims to foster positive attitudes favoring good communication, teamwork, excellence in leadership skills and compliance with standard operating procedures. Another objective of the training is to increase knowledge about human performance and limitations with the purpose of creating a deeper understanding of what can lead humans into lack of situation awareness and complacency.

MRM training focuses on human factor issues and not specific technical tasks. The training is provided to all levels of officers, both deck and engine. Besides the obvious goals of continuous improvement in safer shipping and a reduced number of accidents/incidents, the training aim to assist developing the skills and knowledge of officers and engineers, and enhance their professional standards.
